## **VOTING INFORMATION:**

Voting for supporters of the French Public School Board will be held on:

Advance Poll: Friday, October 17, 2014, 11:00 am to 4:00 pm. at the Township Hall

Election Day: October 27, 2014 from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm at the Township Hall, 1514 County Road 2,

Mallorytown, Ontario.

## **PROOF OF IDENTITY:**

Proof of identity and residence must be presented, showing your name, qualifying address and signature. Examples include Ontario driver's license or photo health card.

## WHO MAY VOTE:

Any supporter of the French Public School Board, who on election day meets the following qualifications, is eligible to vote:

- 1. Is a Canadian citizen
- 2. Is at least 18 years of age on election day
- 3. Resides in the municipality, or is the owner or tenant of land there, or spouse of such owner or tenant
- 4. Any person not prohibited by law from voting.

## **PROXY VOTING:**

If you are unable to attend a voting place on any of the dates set for voting, you may appoint someone to act as your proxy. This person must be an eligible elector in Front of Yonge Township. In order to appoint a proxy, you must obtain an appointment form at the office of the Municipal Clerk. Once you fill it out, the person voting on your behalf must attend the Clerk's office to have the appointment form certified. Contact the Clerk's office for more information.

## ARE YOU ON THE VOTER'S LIST?

The voter's list is available for inspection at the Front of Yonge Township Office, 1514 County Road #2, Mallorytown, Monday to Friday from 9:00 am to 4:30 pm. If you are not on the Voter's list, or the information about you is incorrect, you may fill out an application to be added to the list, or to correct the information. Please note that the Clerk may require that you provide proof of identification or proof of qualification as an elector.
