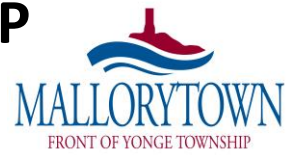

#### EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS WEEK

Emergency Preparedness Week runs from May 4<sup>th</sup> – May 10<sup>th</sup>.

Everyone should ensure their 72-hour kit is ready. This kit should include the following:

- Bottles of water
- Canned food
- Manual can opener
- Flashlight and batteries
- Battery powered or wind up radio
- Extra batteries
- First aid kit
- Special needs items – medications (with a list of required doses), vitamin supplements, list of allergies
- Canes, walkers, hearing aids, breathing apparatus, etc.
- Personal documentation; identification
- Cash (small bills and change)
- List of names and telephone numbers (family members, doctor, etc)

#### COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

**New Kiosk:** The committee is working on a new tourism kiosk to be placed along County Road 2 this summer. There will be rack card holders on one side of the kiosk, and businesses are welcome to drop off some rack cards at the Township Office.

#### BROWN'S BAY PASSES

# **A T T E N T I O N**

## **All Residents and Property Owners**

The Township of Front of Yonge has designated May and June 2014 as  
“Community Clean Up Months”

Residents and property owners are asked to take pride in the appearance of their property and their community. Please make every effort to ensure that you are not in violation of the Safe Properties By-law. This by-law states that every property shall be kept in a neat, tidy and safe condition, and free from:

- a) Refuse (garbage)
- b) Long grass, discarded brush and clippings, excessive weed growth
- c) Timber, lumber, building materials or other material stored or kept under conditions that are unsafe from fire or other dangerous risk or accident
- d) Scrap or junk material including wrecked, unused, unlicensed vehicles, trailers, machinery, tools, appliances, equipment, etc.
- e) Buildings, fences, scaffolding, retaining walls, etc...in an unsafe condition or in danger from fire or risk of accident
- f) Any combustible, flammable, volatile, caustic or explosive substance unless stored under conditions that are safe and free from risk

Front of Yonge Council has authorized the By-law Enforcement Officer to conduct a Township-wide inspection, during the last week of June. Owners/residents who do not meet the conditions of the Safe Properties By-law may receive notices and be given 30 days to clean up their property. Please note that written complaints are kept completely confidential and may be submitted to the Township Office at any time. For the 2014 spring cleanup only, staff have been authorized to receive complaints by telephone or email, as long as the caller leaves their contact information.
