#### WASTE DISPOSAL SITE SUMMER HOURS

FALL/WINTER (Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> to Apr. 30<sup>th</sup>) waste disposal site hours are:

**Tuesdays 11:30am – 4:30pm & Saturdays 9am - 5pm**

SPRING/SUMMER (May 1<sup>st</sup> to Oct. 31<sup>st</sup>) waste disposal site hours are:

**Tuesdays & Thursdays 11:00am-5:00pm & Saturdays 9am-5pm**

**VILLAGE RESIDENTS:** Please ensure your recycling bags are tied at the top. This allows for a quick pick up (and no mess!) for the waste and recycling contractor.

#### 2014 BAG TAGS

There will be NO FREE BAG TAGS for Front of Yonge residents/property owners in 2014. Bag tags must be purchased at either the Township Office or Purcell's FreshMart, at a cost of \$1.50 each. Blue bag tags will still be accepted for 2014.

#### 2014 DOG TAGS

The 2014 dog tags are available at the Township Office. Tag prices remain the same as 2013: \$10 for all spayed/neutered dogs, \$15 for all non-spayed/non-neutered dogs. If you are unable to make it to the office during regular business hours, please mail a cheque (\$10 or \$15), and your dog's information (name, age, colour, breed, sex, etc.) and we will mail your tag(s) to you. **The deadline for purchasing your tags is MARCH 31<sup>st</sup>. Effective April 1<sup>st</sup>, the price of tags will double.**

**ATTENTION DOG OWNERS:** It has come to our attention that there are some areas in the township where dog waste is an issue. Of particular concern, are the roadsides where people regularly walk their dogs. Any owner who does not pick up after their dog, is in violation of Section 3 of the *Licensing, Regulating and Keeping of Dogs By-law #05-09*.

#### INTERIM TAX BILL

The 2014 Interim Tax bills will be mailed out the first week in March, and are due March 31<sup>st</sup>. If you don't receive your bill please contact the Township Office.

#### IMPORTANT: WOODBURNING STOVES OR FIREPLACES

If you are planning to install a solid fuel burning (wood or pellet) stove or fireplace, please be aware that **a building permit is required**. This process will ensure that the stove is properly installed and inspected. Recent events show that an improperly installed stove can cause a fire. Should you already have a stove or fireplace which has not been inspected, please contact the Township immediately, and arrange for an inspection by a certified installer.

## 2014 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

**Nominations are now being accepted for the upcoming municipal election in October.**

**Why?** Every four years, residents and property owners elect their municipal government representatives, and school board trustees.

**What Positions?** The Municipal Government positions are: Mayor (1) and Councillor (4). One school board trustee position is available for each of the four school boards.

**When?** You may file a nomination paper up until 2 pm on September 12, 2014. Election Day will be on Monday, October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

**Where?** Nomination papers are available at the Township Office, 1514 County Road 2.

**How Much?** The nomination fee for Council member or school board trustee is \$100, and the fee for Head of Council is \$200. Payment must be in the form of cash, certified cheque or money order.
