Internet fraud, targeted at Seniors, is a growing concern. Some tips:

- Create strong passwords, and don't share them with others
- Don't expose personal information. Be careful how much personal/financial info you share on sites like Facebook/email. Be careful of quizzes and surveys that ask about your health, wealth, and personal life.
- Never give out your credit card, bank account, or personal information to someone over the phone, at the door, or over the internet unless you know the person/organization
- Do not click on pop-up windows or respond to e-mails, open attachments or go to website links sent by people you do not know. Your bank will not send you anything by e-mail unless you ask them to.
