Until March 31st:


\$12.50 for all spayed/neutered dogs \$20 for all non-spayed/non-neutered dogs

UNITED COUNTIES 2022 ROADS PROJECTS

Beginning in April 2022 there will be a major restoration of County Road 27. This \$4 million project will reconstruct the section of County Road 27 from the CN tracks to the Village of Lyn. Later in the summer, County Road 2 will be resurfaced from the west border of the Village of Mallorytown to the hamlet of Waterton.

GRANT ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Township of Front of Yonge has received two grants that support recreation in our township.

- 1. \$49,900 grant from the Ontario Trillium Foundation to complete work on a Pickleball Court at the Recreation Park. The work will begin in April and we hope to have things up and running for the summer. Pickleball is a sport that can be played by residents of all ages!
- \$72,200 from the Canada Healthy Communities Initiative will be used to develop a trail at the Southwest end of the Recreation Park & to support improvements at the Triangle Ski Club at McIntosh Mills. Both projects will provide opportunities for residents and visitors to stay active!
