#### SECONDARY SUITE PROGRAMS

As an initiative to increase the supply of affordable rental housing for low-income households in Leeds and Grenville, the United Counties of Leeds & Grenville has introduced two Secondary Suite Programs for Leeds & Grenville.

- 1. The Ontario Priorities Housing Initiative (OPHI) Secondary Suite Program targets the creation of a rental unit for low-income households, at a person's sole principal residence. Funding is provided in the form of a 20-year, interest-free forgivable loan to homeowners
- 2. Leeds & Grenville Landlord Secondary Suite Program accessible to small landlords & targets the creation of rental units in a property for low-income households, that is not the landlord's sole and principle residence, and the applicant can own another property. Funding is provided in the form of a 15-year, interest-free, forgivable loan to small landlords.
