Fire Safety Tip for Cottages!

Response times for fire departments could be lengthy depending on the location of your cottage, so have a fire extinguisher there just in case. Big fires start small and can be extinguished before they destroy your cottage. Place extinguishers by the exit so that you have the option of leaving if the fire is growing too fast. If the fire is too big – LEAVE and let the professionals handle it. It is recommended to use a minimum 10lb ABC extinguisher for your cottage.
