include: delivery of frozen meals, transportation services, respite, exercise classes, Lifeline, slips and fall prevention, etc. For more info call 613-342-3693 or go to

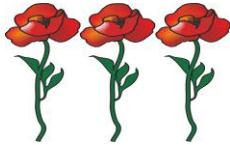
