

NOTICE TO FOY RESIDENTS:

CHANGES TO THE RECYCLING SYSTEM COMING IN 2026!

Effective January 1, 2026, recycling will become even simpler. No matter where you are in the province – home, on vacation, or just passing through – you'll be able to recycle the same materials. *Plus, you'll be able to recycle even more materials!*

WHAT THIS MEANS FOR RESIDENTS IN 2026

Additional materials will now be accepted for recycling. This includes glass, black plastic containers, hot and cold beverage cups (coffee cups), frozen juice containers, ice cream tubs, deodorant and toothpaste tubes.

WHAT IS RECYCLABLE?

How Recycling is Sorted

- **1. Fibre** bin will take paper, cardboard, boxboard, paper laminate packaging, paper laminate containers and cartons. **These materials can all be put together.** Boxes to be flattened; no larger than 60cm x 60cm.
- 2. **Containers** bin will take plastics, styrofoam, metal and glass containers. **These materials can all be put together.** All containers must be empty and rinsed free from residue.

2026 RECYCLING PROGRAM

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2026

Fibre Bin

- Cardboard boxes (pizza boxes, direct mail boxes, moving boxes, shoe boxes)
- Boxboard (Cereal boxes, tissue boxes, egg cartons, rolls from toilet paper/paper towel)
- Paper laminate packaging (pet food bags, food service paper bags & plates)
- Paper laminate containers (spiral cans, cookie dough packages, ice cream containers, hot/cold beverage cups)
- Paper (any colour, including flour bags, prescription bags, paper/produce bags, notepads, white/coloured loose paper, file folders, community newspapers, flyers, brochures, magazines, standard plain gift wrap (remove all non-paper attachments first), greeting cards/envelopes and gift boxes)

Containers Bin

- Hard Plastic Containers (laundry detergent, household cleaner jugs, shampoo, body wash, salad dressing, condiment, dish soap, mouth wash bottles, plastic beverage bottles)
- PET plastic packaging & containers (food trays, salad, yogurt, peanut butter, bakery/egg containers, plastic cups, plastic tubs & lids)
- **Tubes** (toothpaste tubes, deodorant & hand cream tubes)
- Small item plastic packaging (hand sanitizer bottles, medication bottles, blister packs, plant pots)
- Flexible plastic packaging (bags used for dry cleaning, bread, newspapers & flyers. Overwrap, coffee bags or deli pouches, chip bags, bubble wrap, snack wrappers, cereal liner bags, plastic gift bags, milk bags (inner & outer liner))
- **Styrofoam packaging** (meat trays, takeout containers, cups, plates, bowls, foam packaging for products)
- Metal (food cans, metal lids, cookie/coffee/tea tins, beverage cans, aluminum foil, pie plates, frozen food trays, aerosol containers (food spray, hairspray, air fresheners, shaving cream, deodorant))
- Glass clear & coloured glass (food containers, jars/bottles, cosmetic containers, spice bottles, oil/vinegar bottles, non-alcoholic glass beverage containers)
- **Cartons** (beverage cartons, juice/milk cartons, coffee creamers, sugar cartons, soup/sauce cartons)

Batteries, metal and alcohol containers can still be recycled at the Waste Disposal site.

*NOT RECYCLABLE

Alcoholic beverage containers, hazardous materials, diapers, tissues, paper towels, textiles, wood, organics & food, toys, books/novels and batteries.
