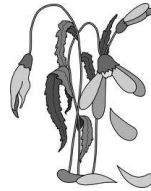


EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

WHAT TO DO IN A DROUGHT EMERGENCY:

During a drought, Emergency Preparedness Ontario suggests taking the following actions to minimize water supply problems:

- Repair all leaks in taps & toilets
- Install low consumption toilets, dishwashers, shower heads, etc.
- Restrict water usage (lawn watering, car washing)
- Choose drought-resistant trees and plants
- Wash only full loads of laundry or dishes



72-HOUR EMERGENCY KITS

It is always a good idea to have an emergency kit prepared at your home at all times. Your kit should include, but not be limited to, the following items: bottles of water, canned food, manual can opener, flashlight and batteries, first aid kit, special needs items (eg. medications, list of allergies, etc.), canes, walker, hearing aids, breathing apparatus, identification, cash, emergency contact list, etc.
