WILDFIRE PREPAREDNESS

Be Ready Before The Fire

1 Stay Indoors

Pay attention to the Air Quality Health Index. Keep windows closed, run A/C on recirculate, and avoid strenuous outdoor activity.

2 Filter Your Air

Use a high-quality HVAC filter or portable HEPA air purifier to reduce indoor pollutants.

3 Wear Protection Outside

If you must go out, use a well-fitted NIOSH-certified N95 mask (do not use for children under 2 or anyone with breathing difficulties).

4 Seek Support

Prioritize your mental well-being and reach out to free resources, such as:

- Health 811
- Kids Help Phone
- Mental Health Support

72-HOUR EMERGENCY KITS

It is always a good idea to have an emergency kit prepared at your home at all times. Your kit should include, but not be limited to, the following items:

- Bottles of water, canned food, manual can opener, flashlight and batteries
- First aid kit, special needs items (i.e. medications, list of allergies, etc.), canes, walker, hearing aids, breathing apparatus, identification, cash, emergency contact list, etc.

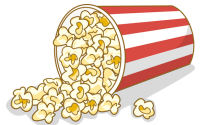
