WHO MAY VOTE?

A person is entitled to vote in a municipal election if they are a qualified elector. On voting day you must be:

- a Canadian citizen
- at least 18 years of age on election day
- Resides in the municipality, or is the owner or tenant of land there, or spouse of such owner or tenant
- Any person not prohibited by law from voting

PROOF OF IDENTITY

Proof of identity and residency must be presented, showing your name and qualifying address. Examples include, Ontario driver's license, Ontario Health Card, Ontario Photo Card.

PROXY VOTING

If you are unable to attend a voting place on any of the dates set for voting, you may appoint someone to act as your proxy. This person must be an eligible elector in Front of Yonge Township. In order to appoint a proxy, you and the person you want to appoint must fill out an appointment form. The person voting on your behalf must attend the Clerk's office to have the appointment form certified. The appointment form can be obtained at the Clerk's office or by visiting the Municipal Elections page on the Township's website at www.mallorytown.ca , found under the Home tab.

ARE YOU ON THE VOTERS' LIST?

The voters' list is available for inspection at the Front of Yonge Township Office, 1514 County Rd 2, Mallorytown, from Monday to Friday, 9:00 am to 4:30 pm. If you are not on the Voters' List, or the information about you is incorrect, you may fill out an application to be added to the list, or to correct the information. Please note that the Clerk may require that you provide proof of identification or proof of qualification as an elector. Applications to add or amend your information on the Voters' List can be found on the Township's website or by visiting the Clerk's Office.
