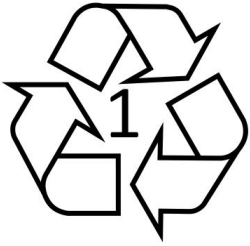

Plastics are the most confusing of our recyclable materials/products. Not all plastics can be recycled, but many are. To identify acceptable plastics, look for the recycling logo with a number in the middle. Logos with numbers 1 - 6 identify the types of plastics that are recyclable. In addition to the numbered plastics, we can also recycle plastic bottles, tubs and jugs, clam shells (food containers), blister packs, salad boxes, boat and shrink wrap, grocery bags, retail bags and outer plastic liners. Please place all plastic bags inside one bag and tie-off; and ensure that recyclable plastic items are rinsed clean.

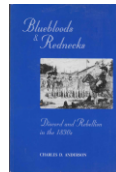
