APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Moved by Richard Marcoux and seconded by Margaret Fancy that Council approve the agenda with the addition of an “In Camera” session.

Discussion took place regarding the waste disposal site. Malroz Engineering has confirmed that waste has gone down by half the disposal rate the past year.

Council reviewed potential reconfiguration concepts for the waste site. Council agreed with the Environmental Advisory Committee's recommendation to move ahead with Concept 2. Pricing and phases for this project will be discussed at the next budget meeting.
