Until March 31st: \$12.50 for all spayed/neutered dogs
\$20 for all non-spayed/non-neutered dogs
After March 31st, the license fee for tags will double

The best way to dispose of unused, unwanted or expired medicines (both prescription and over the counter) is to drop them off at a pharmacy for safe disposal!

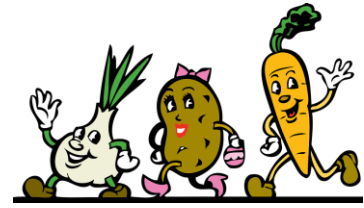


PARKING BY-LAW
