2018 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

If you are interested in becoming part of Front of Yonge Township's municipal Council complete a nomination form for one of the following positions:

Mayor (one to be elected)

Councillors (four to be elected)

The nomination filing fee is \$200 for Mayor and \$100 for Councillor. Payment must be by cash, certified cheque or money order.

Nomination papers are due no later than July 27, 2018 at 2:00 pm.

FINAL TAX BILLS

The 2018 final tax bill will be mailed the first week in June. The first installment is due **June 28th**. The second installment is due **September 28th**. Reminder notices will NOT be sent out for the second installment. Failure to receive a tax bill in the mail does not excuse the taxpayer from the responsibility of payment, nor does it relieve the liability of penalty for late payment. When using online or telephone banking, it's important to make payments at least 3 business days prior to the tax due date in order to meet payment deadlines.
