Community Development Committee

- New street signs/wayfinding signs in the Village of Mallorytown (provincial grant)
- Hiring of Coordinator in partnership with TLTI to support the sales of local food & food products (provincial grant)
- Broadband Awareness Committee established (survey conducted, working with private providers to prepare a grant proposal to Federal government)
- New benches for public spaces
- Sponsored Canada Day Fireworks
- Reached out to businesses to provide links to information related to COVID-19 relief

Recreation Committee

- Partnership with Frontenac Arch Biosphere & library to provide Story Walks behind the library & at the Recreation Park
- Support for initiative to offer online programs & deliver activity kits for children and youth ages 8 to 17
- Resurfacing of tennis court to prepare for pickleball (federal grant)
