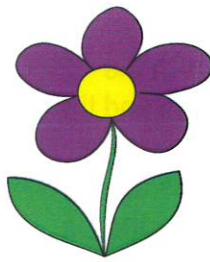

Front of Yonge Township has come to an agreement with the St. Lawrence Parks Commission and the Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands to explore ways for everyone to enjoy the bike path along the 1000 Islands Parkway. The Commission has agreed to provide start-up funding to arrange a volunteer trails committee in co-operation with the Ontario Trails Council to develop plans for year-round usage by hikers, skiers, horseback riding, snowmobiling and just a casual stroll.
