- 1) Jeff Poole called the meeting to order.
- 2) The agenda was approved. Moved by Terry MacKeigan, seconded by Richard Marcoux, carried.
- 3) The minutes of the January 28th meeting were approved as amended. Moved by Carson Massey, seconded by Terry MacKeigan, carried.
- 4) Ongoing Business
 - a) Hay Bale/Boat Wrap Recycling: We are not able to participate in the South Frontenac program due to the limits of their license. We could explore a similar program here.
 - b) WDS Recommendations: Council approved our recommendations. Bill Patterson attended the meeting and provided feedback to our recommendations. Bill suggested that it would require additional funding to achieve these goals. He reported that it would cost \$3000 to extend the incline and \$3300 to widen the road. Some money is already budgeted for these. The Committee agreed that the attendants need a phone and radios for communication, and that power at the gatehouse should be a goal. The Committee agreed that there should be large magnetic signs on the recycling bins.
 - c) The wildlife cameras have been purchased and used with limited success.
- 5) New Business
 - a) WDS Issues Discussion: This was touched upon but not discussed in detail. It was noted that there have been training and personnel issues at the WDS and these are being dealt with. The Committee is committed to helping Bill with advice and support.
