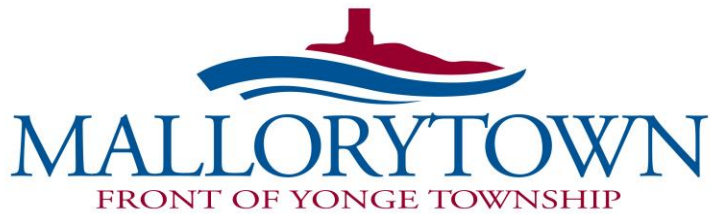

Please place loose plastic bags inside one bag and tie-off. This will help with sorting of plastics at recycling depots and reducing plastic litter at our waste disposal site.

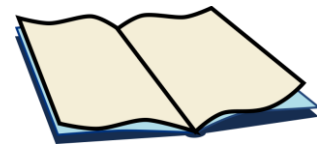


**BUSINESS OF THE YEAR AWARDS –
