### UNITED COUNTIES 2022 ROADS PROJECTS

Beginning in April 2022 there will be a major restoration of County Road 27. This \$4 million project will reconstruct the section of County Road 27 from the CN tracks to the Village of Lyn. Later in the summer, County Road 2 will be resurfaced from the west border of the Village of Mallorytown to the hamlet of Waterton.

### GRANT ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Township of Front of Yonge has received two grants that support recreation in our township.

1. \$49,900 grant from the Ontario Trillium Foundation to complete work on a Pickleball Court at the Recreation Park. The work will begin in April and we hope to have things up and running for the summer. Pickleball is a sport that can be played by residents of all ages!
2. \$72,200 from the Canada Healthy Communities Initiative will be used to develop a trail at the Southwest end of the Recreation Park & to support improvements at the Triangle Ski Club at McIntosh Mills. Both projects will provide opportunities for residents and visitors to stay active!
