Payment must be made by cash, certified cheque or money order.

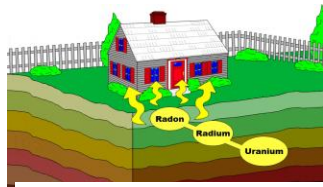

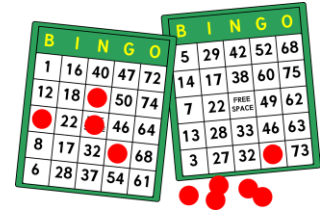
