MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS 2022 INFORMATION FOR VOTERS

INTERNET AND TELEPHONE VOTING NEW FOR 2022 ELECTIONS!

Electors can vote by internet or telephone voting, starting Monday, October 17th at 10:00 am until Monday, October 24th at 8:00 pm. Voter information letters will be mailed to all qualified electors early October. If you are eligible to vote for English Public School Board Trustee or English Catholic School Board Trustee and do not receive a letter, please contact the Township Office. Voter cards containing personal PINs will be mailed closer to the election period.

Electors can choose to vote by paper ballot, in-person at the Township Office on the following dates: Monday, October 17th from 10:00 am - 4:30pm and Monday, October 24th from 10:00 am - 8:00 pm.

WHO MAY VOTE?

A person is entitled to vote in a municipal election if they are a qualified elector. On voting day, you must be:

- a Canadian citizen
- at least 18 years of age on election day
- you qualify to vote for that particular school board

PROOF OF IDENTITY

Proof of identity and residency must be presented showing your name and qualifying address, if voting in-person. Examples include, Ontario driver's license, Ontario Health Card, Ontario Photo Card.

ARE YOU ON THE VOTERS' LIST?

The voters' list is available for inspection at the Front of Yonge Township Office, 1514 County Rd 2, Mallorytown, from Monday to Friday, 9:00 am to 4:30 pm.

If you are not on the Voters' List, or the information about you is incorrect, you may fill out an application to be added to the list, or to correct the information. Please note that the Clerk may require that you provide proof of identification or proof of qualification as an elector. Applications to add or amend your information on the Voters' List can be found on the Township's website or by visiting the Clerk's Office.
