Open regular hours

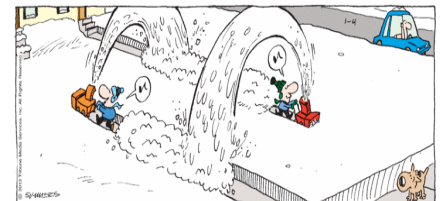

## YONGE IN BLOOM GARDENING TIP - POINSETTIA CARE

They also like to be watered thoroughly when the top few inches of soil get dry but make sure that they do not sit in a saucer filled with water. You can keep your poinsettia for a long time with proper care. You can even plant it out in your garden in the spring!

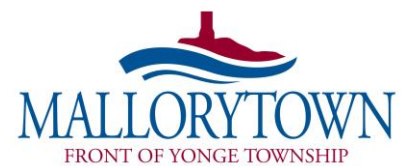
