The Township Office will be **CLOSED** on Monday, November 11th in observance of Remembrance Day

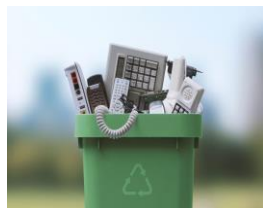


FIRE PREVENTION TIP
