



## **NOTICE TO FOY RESIDENTS: RECYCLING UPDATE**

Front of Yonge is no longer responsible for the Blue Box program. Under the Ontario Government's *Resource Recovery and Circular Economy Act, 2016*, Ontario's Blue Box Regulation shifts responsibility for the Blue Box Program to the organizations that produce products and packaging.

2025 will be a transition year for Front of Yonge with all changes by the province to begin in 2026. Circular Materials has been hired by the province to manage the Blue Box programme. Emterra Environmental has been hired to pick up the recycling.

New Bins – Circular Materials has placed some new bins at the Waste Disposal Site.

## **WHAT WE RECYCLE**

**For 2025, what is recycled stays the same (see back of flyer for a list)**

### **How Recycling is Sorted**

**Fibre** bin will take everything that went into paper, cardboard and boxboard, **so these materials can all be put together**

**Containers** bin – will take plastics and tin cans

**All other bins/recycling remains the same**

### **Collection in the Village of Mallorytown**

Effective January 1, 2025, the Village of Mallorytown recycling collection will be handled by Emterra.

There will be no change to what you currently recycle. Recycling will still be picked up on Tuesday mornings, however recycling must be placed at the curbside by 7:00 am.

## 2025 RECYCLING PROGRAM

### CHANGES FOR 2025

#### Fibre Bin

- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Flyers & inserts
- Catalogues
- Fine paper
- Paper egg cartons
- Box board (e.g. cereal & cracker boxes, paper towel rolls, etc.)
- Polycoated paper – milk and juice cartons, tetra packs, juice boxes (with screw tops removed)
- Flattened corrugated cardboard
- Empty pizza boxes



#### Containers Bin

- Plastics #1 - #6 – **CONTAINERS MUST BE CLEAN!**  
This includes plastic containers, plastic bottles, plastic tubs & jugs, clam shells, blister packs, salad boxes
- Grocery bags, retail bags (Place plastic bags inside one bag and tie-off)
- Milk bags – outer labelled bags **ARE** recyclable  
- inner individual bags are **NOT** recyclable
- Aluminum and tin cans
- Aluminum pie plates
- Aluminum foil

**ALL OTHER RECYCLING BINS  
REMAIN THE SAME**



#### **\*NOT RECYCLABLE**

Styrofoam; glass; bubble wrap; sandwich bags; CD and DVD cases, gift wrap; facial tissues; agricultural and boat shrink wrap; cellophane and kitchen wrap; plastic glasses, plates and cutlery; foil lined boxes or bags; cloth or clothing; hazardous waste; plastic bins, lawn furniture or toys without recycling labels #1-6.
